

Display by Gaye and Graham Chequer-

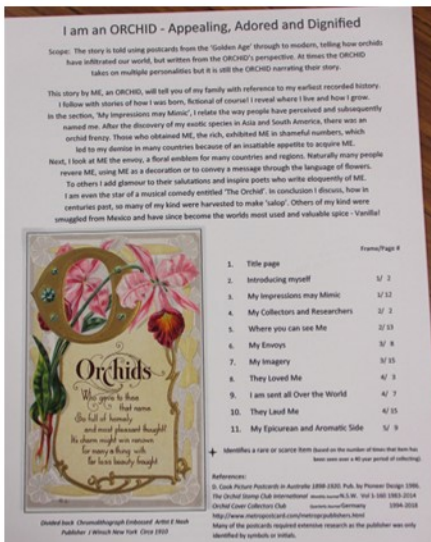
“I am an Orchids—Appealing, Adored and Dignified”

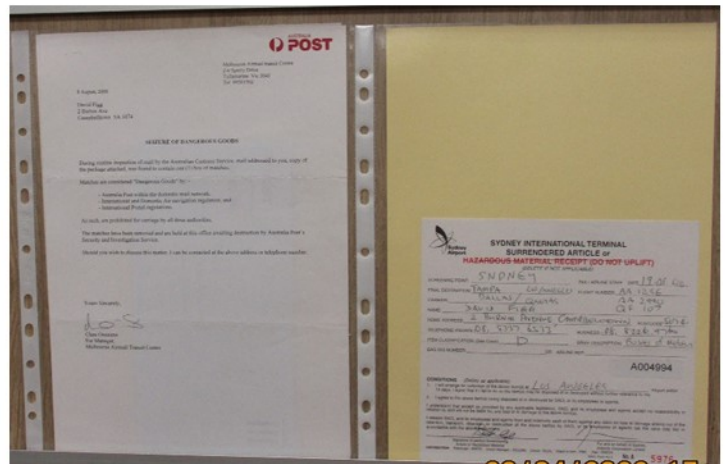

Just 2 of the more colourful pages from the exhibit.

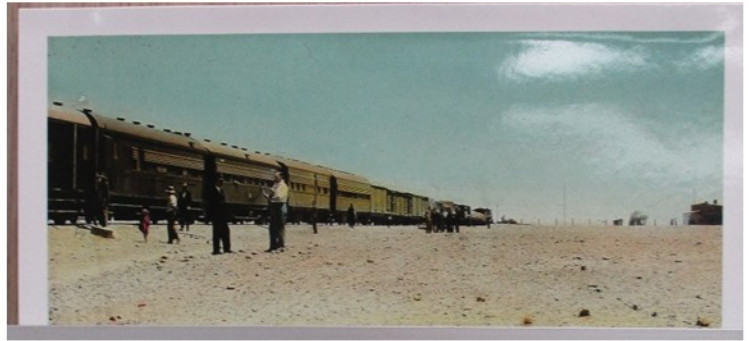

Lastly two pieces of paper from Australia Post given to David for taking Dangerous Goods on planes (matchboxes etc)

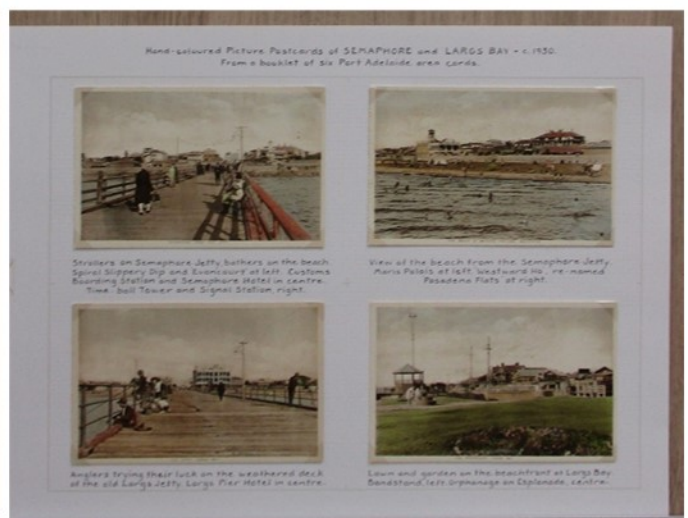
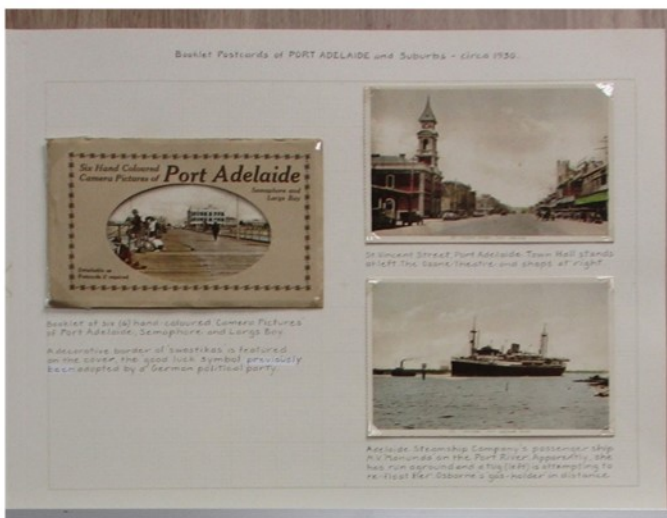

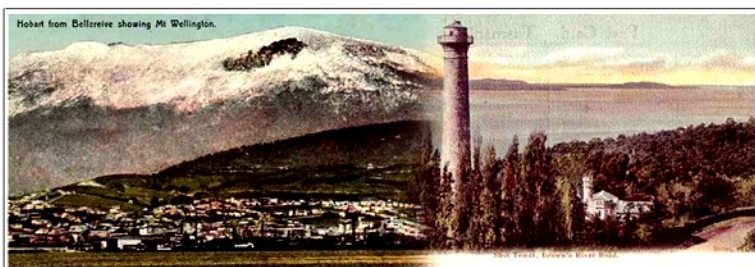
